AFFIRMATIVE	Subject + present affirmative of <b>be</b> + <b>going to</b> + verb (base form)
I'm going to join you tonight at the party.	
NEGATIVE	Subject + present negative of <b>be</b> + <b>going to</b> + verb (base form)
I'm not going to join you tonight at the party	
INTERROGATIVE	Present of <b>be</b> + subject + <b>going to</b> + verb (base form)
Are you going to join us tonight at the party?	

**= present continuous** del verbo *GO* per ogni forma + TO + verbo principale alla forma base
