When do we use it?

In a <u>definite</u> period of time in the past

- Yesterday
- Yesterday morning
- Yesterday afternoon
- Last night

- Last week
- Last month
- Last year

- A year <u>ago</u>
 Two months <u>ago</u>
- Three weeks <u>ago</u>

In general: BASE FORM + ED watch-ED visit-ED play-ED (...)


Orthographic rules

Love > LOVED
 Live > LIVED
 Dance > DANCED

Verbs that end with an E only add D

Chat > CHATTED
 Drop > DROPPED
 Stop > STOPPED

Monosyllabic verbs that end with ONE consonant preceded by ONE vowel double the last consonant



○ Study > STUDIED

Verbs that end with a Y preceded by a consonant change the Y into an I
