

MORE THAN JUST A SPORT, Alifestyle



There are many types of and methods used in making Aboriginal art, including rock painting, dot painting , rock engravings, bark painting, carvings, sculptures, and string art.









For them art is an expression of people's identity, culture, spirituality and relationships to Country. It tells stories of ceremony and Creation and connects people to ancestors and spirits .

























The Aborigines have been living on this land for at least 65,000 years and or the oldest living culture in the world











Jessica Watson


Jessica Watson born 18 May 1993, is an Australian sailor that attempted and succeeded a solo circumnavigation at the age of 16. She sailed out of Sydney Harbour on 18 October 2009 in her pink-hulled Ella Bachè sailing boat. On 13 January 2010 she passed Cape Horn (Chile) .several days after she suffered four knock-downs in a severe storm with 10-metre waves and 130km winds but only did minor damage to her boat. Also when sailing in south of Australia(towards the end of the journey) Watson suffered a lot of bad weather. In this part of the journey, she had at least three knockdowns, one of them with the mast deep into the sea. The waves were near 13 meters tall and 150/ km of wind.



She completed her journey on day 210 of her voyage on 15 May 2010 when she arrived in Sydney Harbour . Jessica Watson currently still holds the world record for the youngest solo circumnavigator and as inspired not only austrailians but young people all over the world.




