- -VANCOUVER: It's in British Columbia. It's especially known for its nature.
- **-MONTREAL:** It's one of the most important cities in Québec, and the second biggest French-speaking city in the world. 85% of the Canadian maple syrup is produced there.
- -NIAGARA FALLS: it's in Ontario. Here are the famous Waterfalls after which the city is named. There is also a bridge that devides the US and Canada.

FIRST NATIONS:


Canadian name for indigenous people, Native Americans.


MÉTIS:
