The most important cities in Canada are:

-OTTAWA: capital, and is called “city of gentlemen” for their politeness.

-TORONTO: is a very big city and it’s the most populous one in Canada. In Toronto is the CN Tower, which between 1975 and 2007 was the tallest skyscraper in the world.

-VANCOUVER: It’s in British Columbia. It’s especially known for its nature.

-MONTREAL: It’s one of the most important cities in Québec, and the second biggest French-speaking city in the world. 85% of the Canadian maple syrup is produced there.

-NIAGARA FALLS: it’s in Ontario. Here are the famous Waterfalls after which the city is named. There is also a bridge that divides the US and Canada.

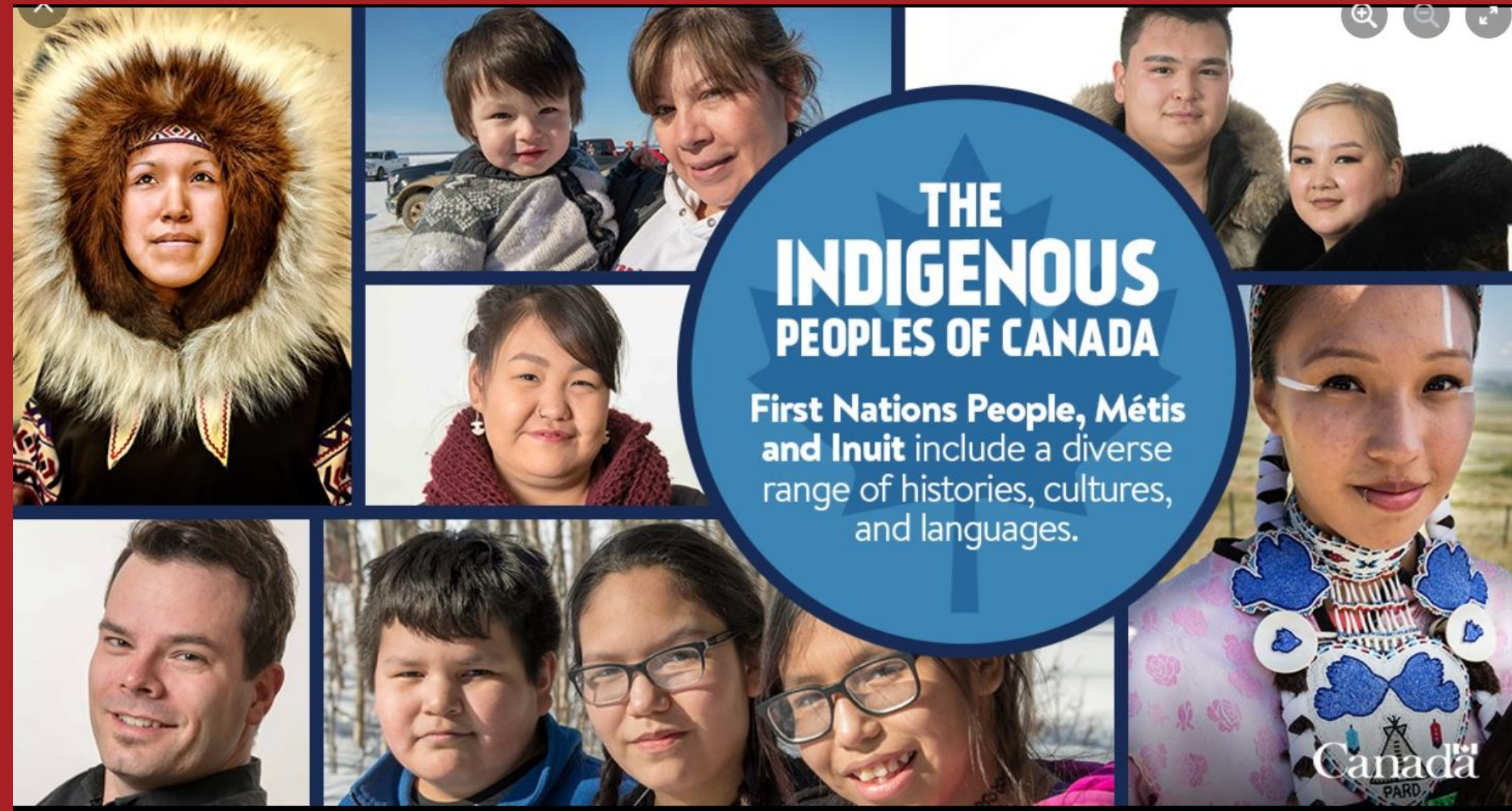
FIRST NATIONS:
