We use INDEFINITE PRONOUNS to talk about people, things or places that are NOT DEFINITE

some / any / no levery

one / body

To talk about people

thing

To talk about things





To talk about places

		ONE / BODY	THING	WHERE
In affirmative sentences	SOME	someone / somebody	something	somewhere
In negative and interrogative sentences	ANY	anyone / anybody	anything	anywhere
In affirmative sentences with negative meaning	NO	no one / nobody	nothing	nowhere
In affirmative, negative and interrogative sentences	EVERY	everyone / everybody	everything	everywhere

The verb after INDEFINITE PRONOUNS is always at the third person singular

Ex: Everyone <u>knows</u> him Everybody <u>is</u> tired Nobody <u>is</u> here
